

Порядок проведения вступительного испытания, критерии оценки результатов вступительного испытания

Вступительное испытание по английскому языку проводится в форме *письменного (компьютерного) теста*. Для каждого абитуриента системой электронного тестирования формируется тест, который состоит из 50 заданий (2 блока). Задания включают в себя вопросы на проверку грамматических и лексических навыков по трем уровням сложности.

Объем материала и содержание заданий соответствуют программе среднего общего образования.

В сумме абитуриент максимально может набрать 100 баллов

На выполнение теста отводится 60 минут

Критерии оценки:

Правильный вариант ответа – 2 балла.

Неверный ответ, отсутствие ответа – 0 баллов.

Требования к уровню подготовки экзаменуемого

Настоящая программа сформирована на основе федерального государственного образовательного стандарта среднего общего (полного) образования и соответствует уровню сложности ЕГЭ по английскому языку (уровень не ниже В1).

В целях подготовки к выполнению теста необходимо повторить следующие темы:

Существительное, прилагательное. Союзы и местоимения. Употребление личных форм глагола в активном и пассивном залогах. Согласование времен. Модальные глаголы. Функции инфинитива. Условное наклонение. Порядок слов простого предложения. Разные типы вопросов. Сложное предложение.
